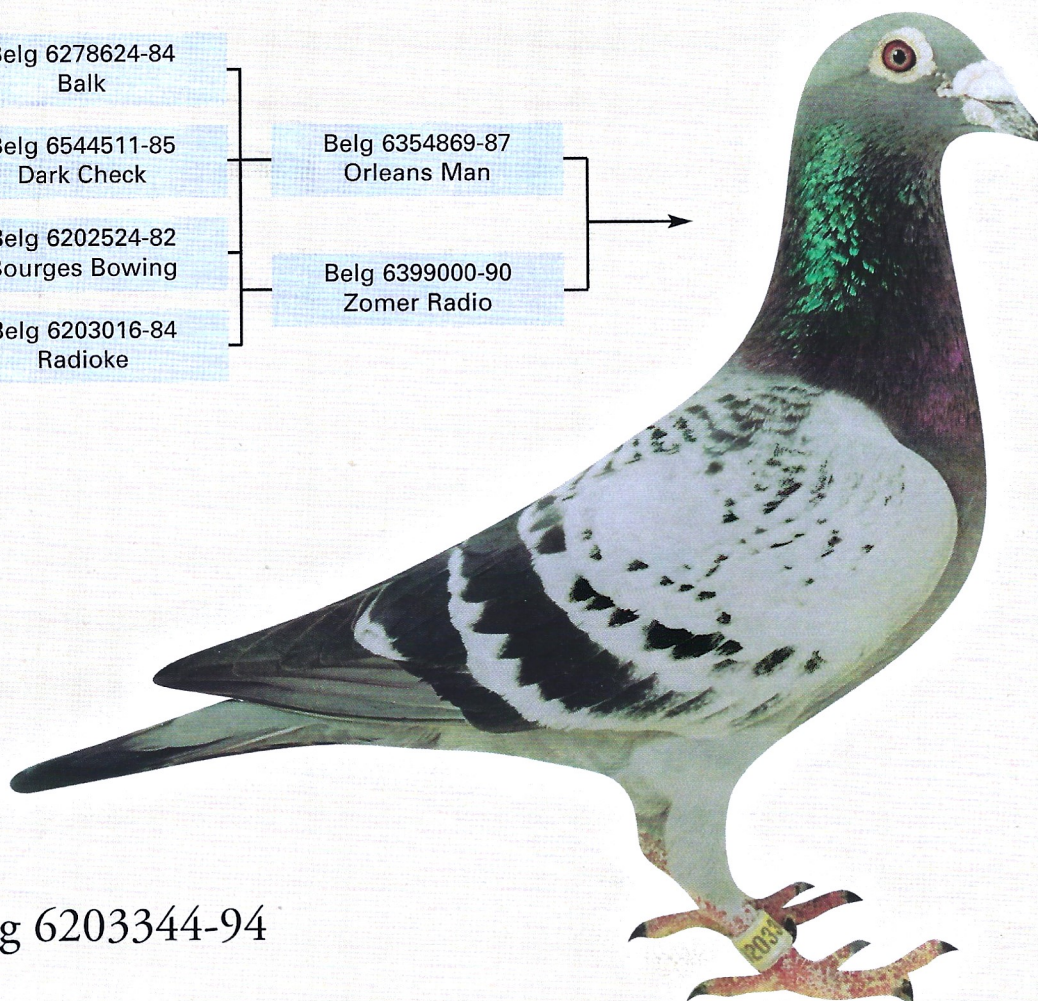

One of the top 10 super birds that I have ever bought. A pigeon that always won his prize and he was usually pooled across the boards most of the time winning all the money. No matter which way the wind blew or how bad the weather was Hercules was home early. This was told to me by Jeff Houben at his 50th wedding anniversary party. The day after this party I went to Mr. VanLoeek's home and bought Hercules.

Hercules's half brother was the 1st National Ace Pigeon KBDB of All Belgium and was purchased by Mr. Nakayima of Japan for thousands of dollars and was also a super breeder.

Hercules is a medium size, strong body, rich eyed proven breeder. In 1997 the first three youngsters I bred off Hercules were sold and they bred several 1st prize winners for Scott Dale, Wally Tienprasid and Vincent Rooney. So I sent Hercules back to Holland in 1998 to my partner loft of Weyst / Ganus where he bred De Joep (NL 1421591-98) a super racer and breeder winning: 2nd National Tours vs 11,866 birds (beaten by my other partner Colijn / Ganus who won 1st National), 3rd National Chantilly vs 13,203 birds, 10th National Chateauroux vs 6000 birds, 15th National Orleans vs 11,601 birds plus more.

In 2001, another son of Hercules won 3rd National Bourges with over 19,000 birds in the race. The percentage of top breeders off Hercules is about 75%. Hercules is back in my breeding loft and he is here to stay.
